The Credentials Form for designation of Delegates, Alternates and Proxy for the 130th Annual Virginia Division Convention is included below. **This form is to be completed and sent to the Chairman of the Division Credentials Committee, Mrs. Donna "Dixie" Robinson, 4632 Water View Drive, Water View, VA 23180-2011, (aeidirtyrags@aol.com; (804) 382-6468)** so that the form is received no later than seven (7) days prior to Division Convention. Chapter Presidents must ensure that the Credentials Committee Chairman receives the form by the **DEADLINE: Wednesday, September 10, 2025**. Any Credentials Form received after the deadline will be considered invalid. Please direct any questions concerning credentials and registration to the Credentials Committee Chairman.

Convention Call – The 130th Annual Virginia Division Convention will be held on September 19-21, 2025, at the DoubleTree by Hilton-Harrisonburg, 1400 East Market Street, Harrisonburg, VA 22801.

Chapter Delegate Representation – Article XVII, Section 5. B. (VOTING) of the recently updated Division Bylaws states: "Each Chapter shall be entitled to representation of two (2) votes for the first seven (7) members, and one (1) vote for each ten (10) additional members, providing credentials were submitted as required and per capita tax for each was paid to the Treasurer General by July 1, as required." Your chapter's voting strength (*i.e., your chapter's total membership*) would include:

1. New members approved by August 31, 2025;
2. Members with per capita tax paid by July 1, even if subsequently resigned or deceased;
3. Members reinstated by July 1; and
4. Members transferred by July 1.

A Chapter is entitled to twice the number of Alternates as Delegates. A table for calculating the number of Delegates (votes) for your Chapter is found on the second page of the Credentials Form. (*Page 11 in the Convention Call.*)

Election of Delegates and Alternates: Each Chapter shall elect their allotted number of Delegates and Alternates in time to mail the Credentials Form to the Credentials Committee Chairman by the deadline indicated on the Credentials Form (*September 10th, 2025*). According to Article XVII, Section 4. C. (ANNUAL DIVISION CONVENTION) of the Division Bylaws: "A Chapter President shall not serve as a Convention Delegate, unless duly elected as such by her Chapter." In the event that a Delegate does not attend Convention or leaves early, the Chairman of the Credentials Committee needs to be informed and is responsible for changing an Alternate to Delegate status.

Personal Votes: According to Bylaws, Article XVII, Section 5.A: "Each Division Officer, Appointive Officer, District Chairman, Past Division President, Honorary President of Division, and Chairman of a Division Standing or Special Committee shall be entitled to one Personal Vote. No member shall cast more than one Personal vote." Personal voting shall begin 30 minutes prior to the opening of the final business session of Convention.

Voting at Convention: Voting will be conducted by District in the final Business Session. A Chapter Delegate shall cast only one vote. In order to vote, each individual Delegate must be present to cast her vote. Chapter Delegate voting shall begin following the final Credentials report.

Process: During the Final Business Session, Chapters shall be called by order of Districts. Any Delegate *not* present when her Chapter is called to vote shall have her Alternate Chapter Delegate to cast a vote, as determined by the order of delegates listed on the Chapter Credentials Form.

Registration: Each Delegate, Alternate, Member and Guest must have completed a Convention Registration Form and have paid the \$10.00 registration fee.
