Join the Historic Staunton River Foundation and the Staunton River Battlefield State Park at the **Clover Visitors Center** and **Fort Hill** as they Commemorate the **161st Anniversary of the Battle of Staunton River Bridge** on **Saturday June 21**. The event will be held rain or shine and is FREE and open to the public.

Saturday June 21

- 9:00AM - Medal Presentation for Descendants of the Battle at the Fort. Confederate reenactors will render a gun salute, followed by the stirring sound of bagpipes.
- 9:30AM - A magnolia wreath will be solemnly cast into the historic waters of the Staunton River Bridge in remembrance of those who made the ultimate sacrifice during the Battle.
- A ceremonial cannon firing will take place from downtown Randolph to commemorate the 161st Anniversary. The salute will begin with a volley at 9:00; 9:30; 9:40; 9:50; and 10:00AM.
- 10:00AM - Park personnel will present "Weapons of the Civil War" at the Clover Visitors Center.
- 11:00AM - Richard Perkins, a descendant, will speak on the history of the Battle of Staunton River Bridge.
- Noon - Park personnel will speak on "Medicinal Plants" at the Clover Visitors Center.
- 2:00PM - Park personnel will give a talk on "Camp Life" during the Civil War at the Clover Visitors Center.
