The document outlines the eligibility and process for becoming a Life Member of the United Daughters of the Confederacy (UDC). Here are the key details:

**1. Eligibility:**

- A Life Member must be at least 70 years old.
- She must be current in her General per capita tax at the time of application.

**2. Application Process:**

- Submit a Life Member Application along with the required fee.
- The fee is \$1,000, but there is a discounted rate of \$500 for those aged 60 or older if the application is postmarked on or before January 31, 2025. After February 1, 2025, the fee reverts to \$1,000.
- The application must follow rules established by the Organization and published in the Registrar's Manual.

**3. Benefits:**

- Life Members retain all rights and privileges of Active Members.
- They are exempt from paying the annual General per capita tax, as this is covered by the Life Member Endowment Fund.

**4. Fund Management:**

- Life Member fees are held in the Life Member Endowment Fund, which earns interest.
- The interest is used to cover the General per capita tax for Life Members annually.

**5. Non-Refundable:**

- The Life Member fee is non-deductible and non-refundable.
